### EL121 Qigong for Weight Management

This Qi Gong class has metabolic boosting exercises which transforms stress into robust energy resulting in desired weight management. If you can do mild squats while standing and are able to get on a mat and do mild breathing exercises, you can easily take this class. You will be given journaling and constructive homework assignments personalized tips for weight loss & healthier eating habits. This class will use a supportive, nourishing with a holistic approach to empower your life style goals.

### FR310 Advanced Curriculum Review: Test-Taking Skills and Strategies

This course provides essential tools on how to approach major standardized exam for TCM graduation, licensure and certification. It breaks down the testing process so that students can confidently sit for their respective exams. Students will practice taking tests each week. Students will learn how multiple-choice tests are designed and how best to prepare for them according to their individual learning styles. Students will create a personal study-schedule to be approved by the instructor. This class is aimed at implementing test skills and not content review.

### FR320 Advanced Curriculum Review: Chinese Herbal Medicine

This course provides a comprehensive overview of the MATCM Herbal Medicine program. The course highlights the key areas of knowledge whilst providing resources, in the form of homework, on more obscure content areas. Students will review all single herbs, formulas and herbal combinations. Students will analyze and deconstruct the use of formulas and their modifications. Much of the course is reviewed in homework and competency will be measured through quizzes and exams.

### FR330 Advanced Curriculum Review: Acupuncture

This course provides a comprehensive overview of the MATCM Acupuncture program. The course highlights the key areas of knowledge whilst providing resources, in the form of homework, on more obscure content areas. Students will review all testable acupoints and their clinical applications. Students will know the various types of channels as well as the categories of function. Much of the course is reviewed in homework and competency will be measured through quizzes and exams.

### FR340 Advance Curriculum Review: Western Biosciences

This course provides a comprehensive overview of the MATCM Western Biosciences program. The course highlights the key areas of knowledge whilst providing resources, in the form of homework, on more obscure content areas. Students will review all areas of medical biosciences with an emphasis on understanding them as systems. Areas that receive less classroom attention will be studied at home. Students will review all clinic sciences and demonstrate competency through the use of quizzes and exams.
