

DETERMINATION OF ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS OF HIGHER EDUCATION EMERGENCY RELIEF FUND SUPPLEMENTAL GRANTS TO STUDENTS (HEERF II)

On 01/19/2021, Yo San University (“YSU”) received the Grant Award Notification from the Department of Education on the supplemental award (HEERF II) to students of \$29,534 on P42E203432 grant. The supplemental award outlines the applicable conditions when awarding grants to eligible recipients.

Use of Funds: Under the CRRSAA, YSU must make grants to students for either of the following:

- Any component of the student’s cost of attendance (COA) or
- Emergency costs that arise due to Coronavirus

HEERF II awards do not have to relate to the disruption of campus operations due to the Coronavirus, but the school is required to prioritize students with exceptional need and funds can be applied to the student’s account to pay an outstanding balance consisting of allowable costs as long as the student opts in and provides a written authorization for the school to do so, and opting in is not a condition of receipt of or eligibility for the grant.

Eligibility: Following the guidelines of eligible HEERF II award recipients, the student must be enrolled in either the MATCM or DAOM program at YSU in the Spring 2021 trimester and have completed the required FAFSA to determine exceptional need.

As such, YSU was able to determine the eligible recipients, broken down as follows:
